The Cross-Media Journalism program offers storytelling strategies and technical training for seasoned professionals who are using multimedia platforms to deliver the news. The week-long program provides the framework for journalistic narrative in print, broadcast and the Internet across the "Fault Lines" of race, class, gender, generation and geography. The program teaches the technical skills necessary to produce multimedia coverage. Participants are taught to lay-out the front page of a newspaper, produce a three-minute TV broadcast and build a Web site.

Faculty and guest speakers provide insider views of the cross-media landscape, teamwork, management challenges, technology advances, and Web research techniques.

The inaugural Cross-Media Journalism training was held at Columbia University Graduate School of Journalism in July 2000. The University of Southern California Annenberg School of Journalism hosted the second training in March 2001 and UC-Berkeley Graduate School of Journalism hosted our most recent program in January 2002.
